



John Joseph Curtin was prime minister of Australia who shifted the forging policy towards the Pacific Ocean region and away from the European area. In 1928 when he entered federal politics he won the Fremantle seat. Shortly after that he was elected prime minister. He died a few weeks short before the allies won the war against Germany.

He was born in Victoria in 1885. Later in life he became a journalist and caught the public's first attention when he opposed conscription into the army. After that he joined the socialist party in 1906, then entering federal politics in 1928. He was soon after that he led the labour party to victory in October 1941.
